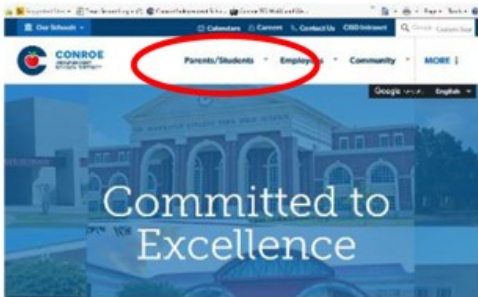

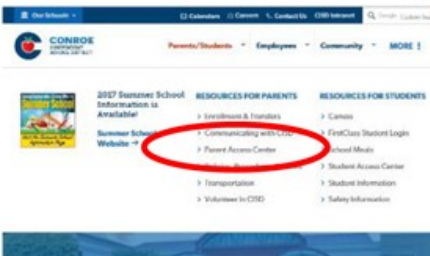
## How to Access STAAR Scores Via Parent Access

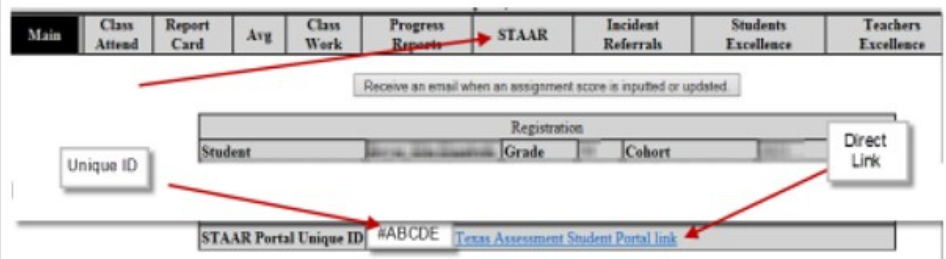
### 4. Click on child's name
